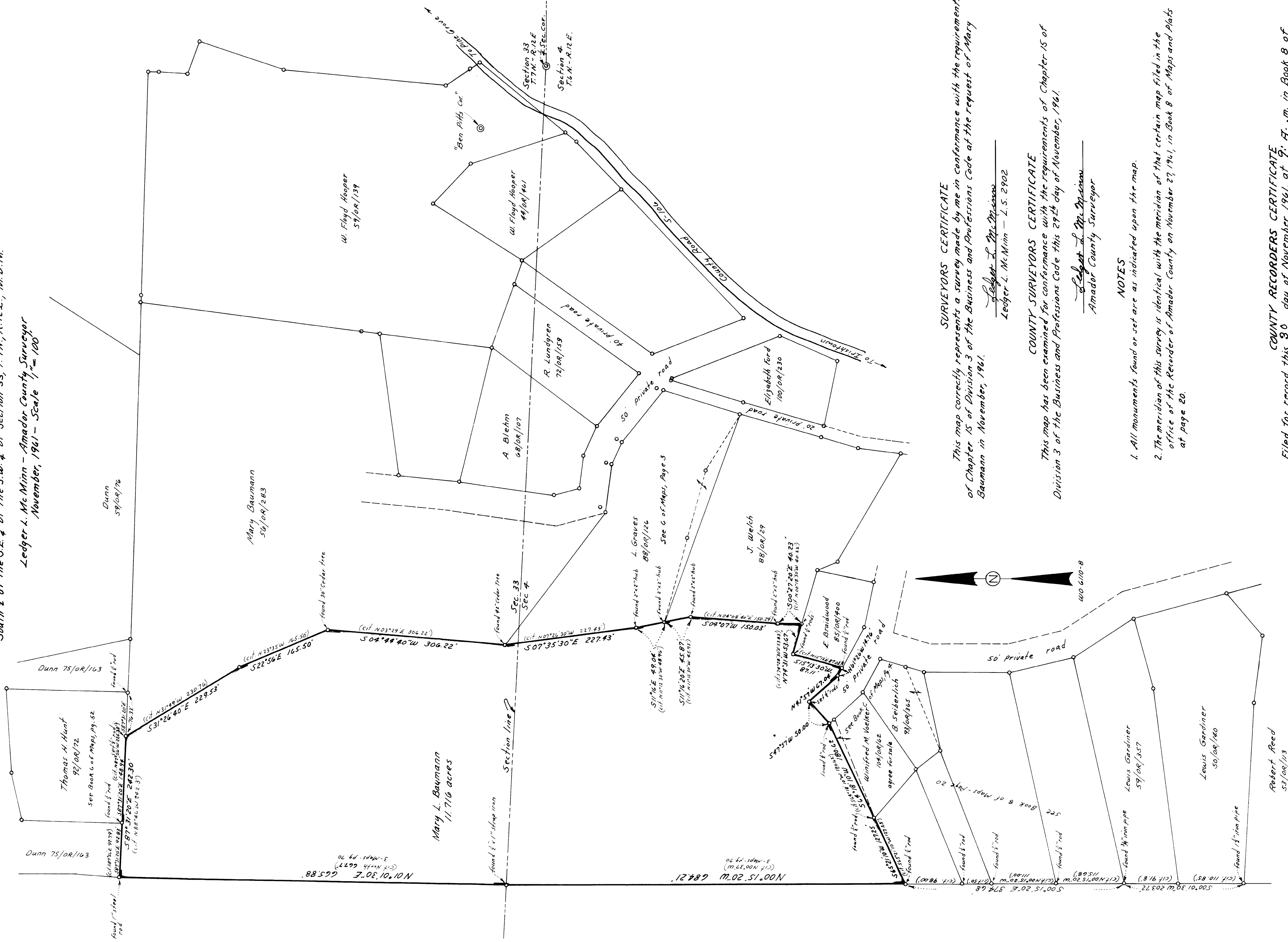


RECORD OF SURVEY
