Bedouin cooperatives work with the project and receive training in skills that will enable them to participate in and benefit from future ecotourism projects. The EEC's work also extends to literacy programmes, English teaching, and study trips to other nature reserves abroad. Bedouin women have been trained in traditional tailoring and embroidery, and local young men have become nature- and bird-watching guides for tourists visiting the Al-Talila reserve.
